



## RFP FOR CONSTRUCTION WORKS FOR 800CUM UNDERGROUNG REINFORCED CONCRETE POTABLE WATER TANK


The University of Global Health Equity (UGHE) plans to enhance its water storage capacity and sustainability infrastructure through the construction of an underground potable reinforced concrete water tank. The tank will have a total capacity of approximately 800 cubic meters (800 m<sup>3</sup>) and will be divided into two equal-sized compartments to allow for maintenance without interrupting supply. An adjacent pump room will be constructed to house all necessary pumping and control equipment, ensuring efficient distribution across the campus.
